Brief Description of Undergraduate Courses Taught: (Course Title – Code: Description)

- Evaluation and diagnosis in special education 309: This course aims to define the concept of
 measurement, the types of measures, the purposes and types of educational evaluation, the areas of
 evaluation (assessment of the learner the teacher the curriculum the administration), the
 principles of evaluation and its various methods, and the methods of evaluating the extraordinary
 students. Children at risk, gifted, learning disabilities, intellectual disabilities and hearing
 impairments.
- 2. Communication Skills 110: The communication skills course aims to help the student to acquire modern concepts in the field of communication, and to identify basic skills in the field of communication with oneself and with others, by using effective teaching methods that depend on the student's activity and motivation to learn through training and self-learning, and to learn skills through teamwork and methods. It also helps the student to develop his skills in verbal communication through learning speaking skills and the foundations on which they are based. It also helps the student to identify effective listening skills. And identifying non-verbal communication skills, it also contributes to helping the student develop the skill of communicating with others by focusing on skills (dialogue, persuasion, negotiation, personal interview, presentation and writing a CV).
- 3. Case Study in Learning Disabilities 311: This course focuses on providing the student with the scientific and methodological bases on which the techniques of case study are based and methods of data collection.
- 4. Lesson Design & Development 415: This course aims to introduce the concept of planning, its importance, levels, and types, the concept of content planning and the definition of basic aspects of learning and implementation skills (preparation skill the skill of presenting the lesson the skill of using appropriate educational aids for people with special needs the skill of capturing attention and strengthening the skill of asking Classroom questions the skill of class control and the skill of summarizing the lesson), methods of teaching spelling for those with learning disabilities and the evaluation skill for groups of learning disabilities. It also addresses the definition of the concept of practical education, its objectives and its importance, as well as the application of the concept of peer evaluation.
- 5. Preparing educational programs for people with learning disabilities 310: This course provides a definition of the concept of the curriculum in general (ancient and modern), the concept of the curriculum for people with learning disabilities and the characteristics of this group in terms of the

programs and the foundations on which to build curricula for people with learning disabilities, and the course provides a study of the objectives of the curriculum (Defining the goal - types of goals - how to formulate educational goals), types of educational experiences and activities in the curriculum, and how to carry out evaluation for a program for people with learning disabilities and examples of programs for people with learning disabilities.

- 6. Teaching strategies for people with learning Disabilities 404: The course deals with important elements that students who teach students with learning disabilities benefit from because they need to know the most important strategies. The course vocabulary includes: the concept of strategy, teaching skills, improving flexibility, strategies for teaching mathematics, strategies for solving problems, strategies for teaching dictation, and ways through which they can teach people with learning disabilities.
- 7. Practical Education 426: This course is a practical application carried out by the students, where the practical education program is implemented over the course of an entire semester by spending the trainee student four days a week in a school of education, provided that the student conducts the teaching process under the supervision of the educational supervisor with the help of the school administration Collaborating teacher; As he applies what he has studied theoretically in various educational preparation subjects in a practical way.
- 8. Introduction to Special Education 104: The course aims to provide students with knowledge through their acquaintance with the concept of special education, its history and objectives, and the distinction between the different categories of special education through the behavioral characteristics of each group separately, and the impact of disability on different aspects of development, and the choice of treatment techniques And ways to modify appropriate behavior for each category. And diagnosing cases and classifying them through knowledge of measurement tools, application of educational programs, and the selection of appropriate methods of teaching for each category.
