Brief Description of Undergraduate Courses Taught: (Course Title – Code: Description)

Principle of Financial Accounting- ACCT202:

This course introduces the objectives of accounting and how businesses keep track of their financial transactions, how they summarize those transactions, and how the summary information is used by individuals and groups both inside and outside of the organization in making decisions. Students will be exposed to the primary financial statements provided by businesses, the information each of these statements contain and how they are used by decision-makers.

This course focuses on helping students to write effectively. The course prompts written communication, preparing reports, writing correspondence and different aspects of business writing. This course is concerned with the development of an effective way to plan and complete writing tasks so that students can meet the requirements of effective writing.
