Brief Description of Undergraduate Courses Taught: (Course Title – Code: Description)

Financial markets and Institutions; FIN303

This course explains the characteristics and functions of financial Systems, markets and institutions; process of financial intermediation and allocation of financial resources; analysis of current developments in financial institutions and in money and capital markets; factors in interest rate determination; management of credit risk, interest rate risk, and operating risk.

International Finance ;FIN 304

The course covers: international financial markets, international banks, international monetary systems, exchange rate determination, government influence on exchange rates, interest rate parity, international fisher effect, exchange rate risk management, managing economic and translation exposures, international capital budgeting, international portfolio investment, international corporate finance, and hedging currency risk exposure from an international perspective.

Alternative Investment INVS 308

Alternative investment is a course to give students the understating of the unconventional industry knowledge and techniques that should be known to an investment analysis or money manager. The course is a supplementary course to the investment analysis course and is considered a main topic in CFA certificate. It focuses on different types of alternative investment and characteristics of the other investment options such as investment in real estate, private equity and venture capital, hedging funds, mutual funds , closely held companies and non-traded securities. This course exposed to the distress's securities and bankruptcies, oil and commodity markets, tangible assets with low liquidity and potential opportunities in emerging markets

**Money and banking FIN
308**

This course offers opportunities for students to understand the overview and importance of financial sector. The emphasis of this course is on the understanding of the financial system, financial institutions, central banks, monetary policy and financial stability. The aim is to give students an overview of the financial system and an understanding of the theory and practice of monetary policy.

Basics and Products of life Insurance INSU 301

The course will provide students with the knowledge of what is life insurance and its products coverage, including traditional insurance as well as investment-linked, group insurance, and retirement plans. It will cover concepts like term Insurance, Whole life insurance, Endowment insurance, Credit insurance Products. This course will teach Marketing life Insurance also the roles and responsibilities of intermediaries.
