Brief Description of Undergraduate Courses Taught: (Course Title – Code: Description)

1	Investment analysis: Key concepts of investment analysis which are explained from an applied perspective emphasizing the individual investors 'decision making issues.
2	Firm valuation: Learn to apply financial and economic theory to investment, financing and dividend decisions to identify ways to maximize shareholder returns. Understand how practical methods to determine costs of capital, total invested capital, free cash flow and economic profits are used in the valuation analysis for mergers and acquisitions, divestitures, capital budgeting, initial public offerings and private placements, leveraged buyouts, performance-based executive compensation, agency costs, control premiums, and costs of marketability and real options.
3	Financial analysis : This course delves deep into financial analysis. Accurate financial analysis is a fundamental element of strategy, growth, and overall success. Understanding how to use financial



	indicators and benchmarks allows you to allocate resources and evaluate potential projects for maximum return-on-investment. Financial analysis takes the guesswork out of the planning process and enables you to build and interpret financial projections. If your job requires a firm grasp of financial situations, then this hands-on comprehensive workshop is for you. You'll review proven analytical tools and develop a keen understanding of how and when to use them to improve your company's profit picture by making sound business decisions
4	Supply chain management : A SUPPLY CHAIN is a network of supplier, manufacturing, assembly, distribution, and logistics facilities that perform the functions of procurement of materials, transformation of these materials into intermediate and finished products, and the distribution of these products to customers. Supply chains arise in both manufacturing and service organizations. SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT (SCM) is a systems approach to managing the entire flow of information, materials, and services from raw materials suppliers through factories and warehouses to the end customer. SCM is different from SUPPLY MANAGEMENT which emphasizes only the buyer-supplier relationship.
5	Financial market and institutions: This course is intended to help you understand the role of financial institutions and markets play in the business environment that you will face in the future. It also helps you to develop a series of applications of principles from finance and economics that explore the connection between financial markets, financial institutions and the economy. On the financial markets side, we will learn the term structure of interest rates, stocks, principals of derivatives, and currencies. On the institutions side, we will learn commercial banks, investment banks, insurance companies, mutual funds, the Federal Reserve Systems and their role of in the economy
