#### Brief Description of Undergraduate Courses Taught: (Course Title – Code: Description)

**Financial Accounting 1 – ACCT 101:** This course is aimed to provide students the principles of financial accounting, and deepening the understanding of GAAP, with regard to the measurement of the statement of financial position.



**Financial Accounting 2 – ACCT 102:** This course aims to complete the study of the principles of financial accounting, and through the recognition necessary for the preparation of financial settlements for operations of the entity's accounting bases at the end of the period, with an indication of their impact on the final accounts and financial statements, as well as deepen the student's understanding of the principles and problems of the accounting treatment of the accounts of assets in general, with a focus on current assets accounts.

**Accounting for Governmental Org – ACCT 373:** The course includes the nature of the units of government, business, industry and the differences and similarities between the two, also includes Accounting Measurement Bases, and the rules and provisions of the preparation of the general budget of the kingdom, also includes the accounting treatment for revenue and expenses, and financial reports and accounts and the annual final accounting system in government units.

**Auditing I – ACCT 361:** This course seeks to introduce students to the profession of auditing through the definition of the concept of review and study phases of international and local development with interest in the study of professional auditing standards and rules of professional conduct in the Kingdom, in addition to focusing on the study of the internal control system of the facility and its impact on the procedures and the scope of review in accordance with the specific program review. As well as the exposure to the types of audit reports, highlighting the basics of internal audit firms.

**Principles of Financial Management - FIN 101:** This course describes the concept of financial management, objectives and components of the financial system. It also describes the income statement and balance sheet and financial indicators used in the company's performance evaluation from different dimensions such as activity, profitability, liquidity, indebtedness. It discusses the market performance of the company's shares. As well as cash management and inventory management, receivable accounts management and working capital management.

**Corporate Finance – FIN 288:** This course describes corporate finance concept, the concept of finance structure and the structure of capital in joint stock companies, and the classification criteria of funding sources such as; sources of funding for short and long-term, sources of funding for ownership and indebtedness, sources of permanent and temporary funding, sources of internal and external funding, automatic and negotiating funding. This course also discusses the systematic cost of each source of finance for joint-stock companies, the calculation of weighted average cost of capital structure, and the statement of the effect of changing the relative weight of funding sources by the weighted average cost



of funding. This is used due to the cost of financing structure and methodologies for evaluating investment projects in ways that take into account the time value of money, namely: discounted payback and net present value and internal rate of return and profitability index period. Under conditions and to make sure risk and uncertainty and evaluation methods to assess investment proposals.

**Bank Management – FIN 321:** This course describes the functions of commercial banks and specialized banks, the difference between conventional banks and Islamic banks. It deals with the Central Bank or the Saudi Arabian Monetary Agency, financial statements in banks, banking performance indicators and the types of deposits and their characteristics. The structure of the Bank's investments, policies and lending.
