Brief Description of Undergraduate Courses Taught: (Course Title – Code: Description)

Fundamental of Nursing II 1610-252

Theoretical and practical components of this course are designed to provide students with an opportunity to demonstrate competency in performing basic nursing skills for individuals with common health alterations. The clinical labs will include simulations and interactions with patients in hospital or nursing home settings.

Geriatric Nursing 1610-441

This course focuses on the normal and abnormal changes in elderly, the major causes of mortality and morbidity for the elderly and the roles of a nurse in promoting

Medical Surgical Nursing I 1610-311

The course provides the student with the necessary knowledge, skills and attitude that would enable them to provide high quality nursing management for Medical-Surgical patients in both general medical and surgical wards. This is in addition to the different therapeutic modalities used for both medical and surgical patients. However, the student is expected to integrate knowledge derived from other courses taken previously or simultaneously.

Medical Surgical Nursing II 1610-312

The course provides the student with further in-depth knowledge, skills and attitude necessary for high quality nursing management for Medical-Surgical patients in specialized medical and surgical wards, as well as emergency room, operating room and recovery room, day surgery and hemodialysis unit. This is in addition to the different therapeutic modalities used for both medical and surgical patients. However, the student is expected to integrate knowledge derived from other courses taken previously or simultaneously.

The course also focuses on the application of nursing process and utilization of self-care concepts in providing comprehensive nursing management for medical and surgical



patients with special consideration to the maintenance of patients' safety throughout care and promotion of home and community-based care

Psychiatric and Mental Health Nursing 1610-331

This course focuses on integration of knowledge and skills to provide high quality nursing management for clients with emotional and psychiatric problems in different health care settings. Emphasis on providing effective nursing care for clients with different mental disorders. The basic knowledge regarding the concept of mental illness, classification of mental disorders, clinical pictures and the treatment modalities will be emphasized.

The course presents concepts of nursing process as a framework for the psychiatric nursing care plan. In addition, the course strives to assist the student to promote mental health, to recognize and to prevent mental illness, and to participate in the restoration of mental health and rehabilitation of client who is emotionally ill
