Brief Description of Undergraduate Courses Taught: (Course Title – Code: Description)

1	Enteral and parenteral nutrition, NUTR 325, the course aims to give the rationale and criteria necessary to support appropriate nutrition, focuses on intestinal and intravenous nutrition, formulation formulation, drug administration, complications monitoring and nutritional support at home care settings.
2	Nutritional assessment, NUTR 326, this course gives listeners to choose the best direct or indirect methods of nutritional evaluation for people, whether in clinics or in social gatherings, and focuses on collecting data and then analyzing, understanding and nutritionally evaluating it.
3	Meal planning, NUTR 224, knowledge in planning and calculating energy and daily needs of macronutrients and micronutrients for healthy people of all ages.
4	Community Nutrition, NUTR 325, implement the knowledge of the nutritional patterns of different societies, focusing on the immediate surrounding community which is the Arabs and Muslims, and the focus and knowledge of food transmission in the current era and its impact on the health of individuals.
5	Basics of Human Nutrition NUTR213, his course will focus on basic concepts of human nutrition to maintain health and prevent disease. The course will enable the students to describe the roles and functions of macro and micronutrients in human health. Also, students will realize the main natural sources, the effects of excess or deficiency, and recommended dietary intakes of essential nutrients.
6	Food preparation and processing NUTR 311, This course represents information related to food science and nutrition, such as food selection, sensory and physical evaluation.
7	Food service and quality NUTR 313, The course provides a general knowledge of the health specifications needed to guarantee high quality throughout the entire food chain.
8	Medical Nutrition Therapy Application I This course provides the students with required skills to work with the health care team as a qualified dietitian. Students will learn how to apply all steps of nutrition care process (NCP) in hospitals.
9	The student will learn theories that enhance their communication skills in planning and implementing nutritional education programs to improve the dietary habits of individuals and target groups.
10	This course focuses on studying the main diseases resulting from specific nutrients deficiency, excessive or imbalance of certain nutritional intake. Focus will be on the prevalence, clinical and biochemical signs, vulnerable groups, contributed risk factors, health consequences along with worldwide suggestions of nutritional intervention to overcome these diseases.
