This is in addition to the different therapeutic modalities used for both medical and surgical patients. However, the student is encouraged to integrate knowledge derived from other courses taken previously or simultaneously.

The course also focuses on the application of nursing process and utilization of selfcare concepts in providing comprehensive nursing management for medical and surgical patients with special consideration to the maintenance of patients' safety throughout care and promotion of home care through discharge plan.

- **3. Obstetric and Gynecologic Nursing Care :** This course is designed to enable 3rd year students to attain the necessary knowledge, skills and attitudes that enable them to provide high quality care and safety measures for women throughout pregnancy, labor & delivery, postpartum and newborn and women with common gyne. problems in the skill lab.
- **4.
