Brief Description of Postgraduate Courses Taught: (Course Title - Code: Description)

1	Principles of Management : The course aims to discuss and communicate the management evolution and how it will affect future managers. 2. Observe and evaluate the influence of historical forces on the current practice of management. 3. Identify and evaluate social responsibility and ethical issues in volved in business situations and logically articulate own position on such issues. 4. Explain how organizations adapt to an uncertain environment and identify techniques managers use to influence and control the internal environment. 5. Practice the process of management's four functions: planning, organizing, leading, and controlling.
2	E-business : Presents concepts and skills for the strategic use of e-commerce and related information technology from three perspectives: business to consumers, business-to-business, and intra-organizational. Examination of e-commerce in altering the structure of entire industries, and how it affects business processes including electronic transactions, supply chains, decision making and organizational performance.

	 Total Quality Management (TQM) is a scientific approach for management and employees to be involved in the continuous improvement of processes underlying the production of goods and services. This approach is fundamental in business, industry, evidence-based medicine and many other disciplines. Students who complete this course will be able to critically appraise management techniques, choose appropriate statistical techniques for improving processes and write reports to management describing processes and recommending ways to improve them.
4	<u>Principles of Finance and Investment</u> : This course, introduce students to a variety of topics in finance and investment, these topics include, Fundamentals of finance Financial statements, Introduction to financial markets and players, Time value of money and its applications Bonds and stocks and their valuation, Long term financial management and capital budgeting techniques Risk and return, CAPM and cost of capital Investment fundamentals
5	<u>International Finance</u> : The course focuses on understanding the theory of international finance and on its real world applications from a business point of view. Understanding the foreign exchange markets and world capital markets (banking, debt and equity) is necessary to carry out a sound and effective management of the firm from a financial point of view. And since multinational corporations face opportunities but also risks, financial management involves the design of appropriate strategies to hedge the com pany from actual and potential risks through the use of the different types of financial assets (such as derivatives) available for this
