Brief Description of Undergraduate Courses Taught: (Course Title – Code: Description)

Money and banking (FIN 308)

This course offers opportunities for students to understand the overview and importance of financial sector. The emphasis of this course is on the understanding of the financial system, financial institutions, central banks, monetary policy and financial stability. The aim is to give students an overview of the financial system and an understanding of the theory and practice of monetary policy.

Marine Insurance (INSU 211)

This course provides students with the basic knowledge of marine transportation, cargo insurance policies and procedures. It examines the regulations and practices of marine insurance on an international basis and provides practitioners the information required to rapidly and precisely resolves cargo insurance coverage issues, wherever they may arise. The course also investigates how the Institute Cargo Articles have been construed by Courts worldwide. The course also covers maritime transport legislation.

Motor Insurance (RISK 112)

This course provides students with knowledge of different types of motor coverages and compulsory insurance requirements. It will make students learn the different legal aspects of motor insurance contracts and the basics of underwriting. The course will also explain Ratemaking and how to construct a private insurance policy with the application of information and communication technology principles in a given set of circumstances. It will also provide students with knowledge of the main products of motor insurance, especially in Saudi Market. It explains also the role of the main actors related to the motor Insurance sector.

Transportation Risk Management (RISK 203)

This course provides an introduction to transportation risk management. It covers risk management of different transportation modes, including road, marine, air and pipeline transportation models. This course provides students with the basic knowledge of regulations and practices of different modes of transportation. It provides also practitioners the information required to rapidly and precisely resolves transportation insurance coverage issues, wherever they may arise.

Motor Insurance (RISK 112)

This course provides students with knowledge of different types of motor coverages and compulsory insurance requirements. It will make students learn the different legal aspects of motor insurance contracts and the basics of underwriting. The course will also explain Ratemaking and how to construct a private insurance policy with the application of information and communication technology principles in a given set of circumstances. It will also provide students with knowledge of the main products of motor insurance, especially in Saudi Market. It explains also the role of the main actors related to the motor Insurance sector.

Principles of Economic (ECON 201)

This course introduces students to fundamental concepts of economics. It explores both microeconomics and macroeconomics topics such as supply, demand, elasticity, consumer behavior, production, costs, national income accounts, aggregate demand, aggregate supply, inflation, unemployment, fiscal policy, and monetary policy.
