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Historical Background

The College of Nursing (CON) was established as a department in 1989 (1409-1410 Hijri) by King Faisal University under the Academic Department of the College of Medicine and Medical Sciences. This department initiated the first BSc program in nursing which had the first six female graduates in 1994, in the Eastern Province of the Kingdom.


The needs of Saudi society for well qualified Saudi nurses, King Faisal University urged for the establishment of a College of Nursing. The meetings held on 2/11/1423H by the Supreme University Council decided to transform the Department of Nursing into a College. This decision was supported by the Council of Ministers and approved by the Royal Decree Number 7/B/45888 dated 23/11/1423H, therefore the first College of Nursing in the Eastern Province of the Kingdom was established. The college of Nursing includes three academic departments: Fundamental of Nursing, Community Nursing and Nursing education.

Since 2008, the College of Nursing provides master's in clinical nursing in the following specialties: Critical Care Nursing, Obstetrics and Gynecology Nursing, Paediatric Nursing, Psychiatric and Mental Health Nursing and Medical Surgical Nursing. Also, College of Nursing had parallel bridging program for diploma nurses to upgrade their degree to BSc. This program was opened for female in 2013 and for male 2014.

Since the College of Nursing was established, it attracted many females, however, since 2011 the College of Nursing opened the opportunity for male students to join the College.



Undergraduate Nursing Program: Stream 1

The curriculum of the Bachelor of Science in nursing, at the Imam Abdulrahman bin Faisal University in Dammam, KSA is distinguished by its comprehensiveness and objectivity. It has been reviewed in a scientific and methodical way to match accredited curricula in International Universities, academic developments and applications to meet the requirements of the NCAAA. The curriculum deals with the health problems peculiar to the Saudi Community, so as to avail for potential employer's graduates possessing scientific & practical skills that have been improved academically.

Duration of the Program: 4 Years / 12 Semesters plus one year of internship. The student is not allowed to move from one level to another until he/she fulfils the prerequisites of the previous level.

The Program comprises 3 phases:

Phase one: Preparatory Year Phase (first academic year = 2 Semesters): preparatory year program is a prerequisite for all students who are admitted by the colleges participating in the preparatory year. The study in the preparatory year program comprises two semesters. It could be extended to one more semester in the summer.

Study in the preparatory has several educational tracks or sectors or paths.

Each track has its own group of colleges as follows:

- Health path: College of Medicine, College of Dentistry, College of Applied Medical Sciences, College of Nursing, College of public health and College of Clinical Pharmacy.

Undergraduate Nursing Curriculum

Acceptance in the Nursing Curriculum is approved by initially by provided that:

- The student passes all the courses provided in the preparatory year program.
- The student obtains a cumulative average of at least 3.00 out of 5.00 at the end of the second semester of the preparatory year.
- The student obtains a minimum grade of good (C) in all English language courses or a score of 450 in the TOFEL test.

Internship Year

After a successful completion of all academic requirements, the students have to do one year (52 weeks) of internship. This period enables the student to enhance one's practical experience. The student spends this period in KFHU in Al Khobar, and other hospital approved for training as they provide suitable training facilities to cover all objectives of the internship program.

Actual practical training period is 52 weeks 40 hours per week, distributed as follows:

Admission Requirements

1. Have a “very good” in bachelor degree or High Diploma degree in nursing.
2. Have a minimum grade of “very good” in the area of specialty.
3. Be enrolled as a full-time student.
4. Demonstrate English language proficiency in personal interview or by passing a written admission examination.
5. Have a minimum of two years clinical experience in Nursing including the Internship Program.
6. Provide a letter of support for their studies from their employer and two letters of recommendation to be sent directly to the Director of the Program.
7. Be physically fit.
8. Have a current license for nursing practice.





Student Services: Academic Advising & Counselling

- Academic advising and counselling service is an assistant educational system, whereby faculty members introduce the students to the university and college systems and inform them by their roles, responsibilities, and rights. Academic advising and counselling service provides guidance and support for students to overcome any academic problems or personal difficulties that may hamper student's academic progress, as well as develops the students' capacities and potentials, that enhances their academic performance.

- Become knowledgeable concerning university rules, policies, regulations and procedures that affect academic programs and activity.
- Help students have better understanding skills, self-development and enhance their self-confidence by identifying their strength and weakness.
- Keep resource materials as the Student Handbook, college rules and Regulation, academic calendar, class schedules and other useful resources on hand to answer questions about academic and non-academic concern.
