

RENAL ULTRASOUND PREPARATION

Ultrasound imaging (sonography) uses sound waves to create images of internal organs and tissues.

Preparation:

- Wear comfortable clothes; you may be asked to change into a gown.
- Drink 5 glasses of water 1 hour before your exam.

During the Test:

- The sonographer will apply warm gel to the area being examined and glide the transducer over the skin to capture images.
- The test is painless and takes about 20-30 minutes.

After the Test:

- Resume normal activities.
- A radiologist will read the images and share the results with your doctor, who will discuss them with you
