Childlessness increases chances of incidence of ovarian cancer.

Having a family history of cancer such as: ovarian cancer, endometriosis, breast and colorectal cancer increases the chances of infection by 10-15%.

Having a genetic mutation, especially in the breast cancer gene (BRCA Gene)
