

<p>1. <b>TITLE:</b> <b>DISABILITY SERVICES OFFICE POLICY</b></p> <p>2. <b>PURPOSE:</b></p> <p>2.1. These policy is planed to the students, staffs and faculty with impairments, to have equal rights in Imam Abdulrahman Bin Faisal University employment and educational access in compliance with the workers right. The goal is to develop specific skills without depending on others to make them productive members of society.</p> <p>3. <b>DEFINITIONS:</b></p> <p>3.1. A disabled person, as defined by labor law, is any person who, according to a medical report given by the Ministry of Health or hospitals of other government agencies, or according to an identification document issued by the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Services, has one or more of the following disabilities: (visual impairment, Intellectual impairment, Physical impairment, Loss of motor, Learning Disorder, Speech Difficulties, mental and behavioral deficiencies) or any other impairments requiring accommodation in any form.</p> <p>4. <b>POLICY:</b></p> <p>4.1. The University is committed to developing, maintaining and promoting a culture of equality and diversity in he world of work in which students, employees and applicants are treated equally, regardless of their disability.despite their condition.</p> <p>4.2. Employers have a responsibility to modify their practices and context to reasonably accommodate individuals with disabilities, where any workplace amenities or physical charecteristics result in a severe disadvantage. There are several appropriate changes that a person may make in order to cope with a difficult situation. These could include adjusting one’s schedule, changing one’s habits, or seeking out support.</p>		
<p>Employers have a responsibility to modify their practices and context to reasonably accommodate individuals with disabilities, where any workplace amenities or physical characteristics result in a severe disadvantage. 





### Physiotherapy Department

Physiotherapy Department rendered services thru electronic referrals with clear diagnosis and precautions from the concerned dept. as needed. Physical Therapist will contact the referring physician for anything related to the patient.

The inpatient units that depend on Physiotherapy services are Critical Care Units (CCU, CCU), Orthopedic, Neurosurgery, General Surgery, Neurology, Internal Medicine and Pediatric.

The physiotherapy services may include relief of pain, improve the range of motion, improved the muscle power, training of activity of daily living, gait training and improving human performance.

Occupational Therapy is under the umbrella of physiotherapy department. It also considers the physical aspects of rehabilitation and motion, but it is focused primarily on enabling the patient to engage in the meaningful activities of daily life as seamlessly as possible. Occupational Therapists are dedicated to assisting patients in the long-term through therapeutic adaptations to their environments that fit in their specific functional limitations.

Physiotherapy Department staffed with highly qualified Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists, and Physiotherapy Clinicians.

- Assistive walking aids

Occupational therapy performance area:

- Activity of daily living (ADL)
- Productivity (work)
- Leisure (play)

Occupational therapist assessed the following:

- Sensory motor component like muscles power
- Psychosocial component like social interaction
- Cognitive component like memory

Occupation therapy provides patient-centered service like but not limited to:

- Cerebral palsy
- Stroke
- Head injuries
- Erbis palsy
- Spinal cord injuries
- Down syndrome
- Mental health difficulties
- Upper limbs injuries

## 12. IAU celebrated the graduation of 17 graduates of the first batch of the Administrative Communication Skills Diploma for Deaf




### IAU Celebrate the First Batch of the Admin. Communication Skills Diploma for Deaf

The President added, at King Fahd Hospital of the University, we have a cochlear implant program in which 200 cochlear implant surgery were conducted successfully. Services and full care were provided through specialists, who have been rehabilitated, educated, and prepared to overcome this difficulty. Today, the university has another new educational program for visually impaired students.

#### Conditions and controls for admission of students with disabilities:

11. ألا يقل نوع الإعاقة المطلوب وحالته المسجدة خلال دون يومه بمرئسة وتطبيق المهارات الأساسية والواجبات اليومية والاختبارات اللازمة والمتطورة لإكمال متطلبات التخرج من البرنامج الذي تم قبوله فيه.


