
All IAU buildings are constructed in keeping disabled people in mind and that is why all IAU campuses are a convenient place for disabled people to easily access.




Disabled patient ramp (IAU) at the entrance of Each College (IAU)







Physiotherapy Department

Physiotherapy Department rendered services thru electronic referrals with clear diagnosis and precautions from the concerned dept. as needed. Physical Therapist will contact the referring physician for anything related to the patient.

The inpatient units that depend on Physiotherapy services are Critical Care Units (CCU, CCU), Orthopedic, Neurosurgery, General Surgery, Neurology, Internal Medicine and Pediatric.

The physiotherapy services may include relief of pain, improve the range of motion, improved the muscle power, training of activity of daily living, gait training and improving human performance.

Occupational Therapy is under the umbrella of physiotherapy department. It also considers the physical aspects of rehabilitation and motion, but it is focused primarily on enabling the patient to engage in the meaningful activities of daily life as seamlessly as possible. Occupational Therapists are dedicated to assisting patients in the long-term through therapeutic adaptations to their environments that fit in their specific functional limitations.

Physiotherapy Department staffed with highly qualified Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists, and Physiotherapy Clinicians.

- Assistive walking aids

Occupational therapy performance area:

- Activity of daily living (ADL)
- Productivity (work)
- Leisure (play)

Occupational therapist assessed the following:

- Sensory motor component like muscles power
- Psychosocial component like social interaction
- Cognitive component like memory

11. IAU celebrated the graduation of 17 graduates of the first batch of the Administrative Communication Skills Diploma for Deaf




IAU Celebrate the First Batch of the Admin. Communication Skills Diploma for Deaf

10. أن يحال المتقدم للاختبارات المطلوبة من قبل الجامعة.

11. ألا يقب نوع إعاقة الطالب وحالته المسجلة خلال دون إقامته ببرنامج وطبقت المهارات الأساسية والواجبات اليومية والاختبارات اللازمة والمتطورة لإكمال متطلبات التخرج من البرنامج الذي تم قبوله فيه.
