





The Deanship of eLearning and Distance Learning successfully migrated and archived 100% of courses to the new system, fully trained and certified the technical team, and launched an extensive training plan that included 18 workshops for faculty members and 6 workshops for students, delivered in both Arabic and English. 

12. Admission Portal for Disabled Students at IAU

Conditions and controls for admission of students with disabilities:

Imam Abdul Rahman bin Faisal University is keen to provide the opportunity for students with disabilities who wish to study, by allocating a number of study seats in the programs available to them according to the category of disability and their health status, without prejudice to the controls and mechanisms regulating the admission of students, which include fulfilling the following conditions:

1. The applicant must be a Saudi or a non-Saudi of a Saudi mother (son of a female citizen)
2. The applicant must have obtained a high school diploma or its equivalent, and that no more than five years have passed since the date of his graduation.
3. He must have taken the aptitude and achievement tests within a period not exceeding five years at the time of submission. (And he can be exempted from this condition based on a statement from the National Center for Assessment).
4. The student must fill in the admission application data through the admission portal website in the period specified for receiving applications for admission.
5. The student's disability and health status should not prevent him from practicing and applying the basic skills necessary and required to finish the study program he will be joining.
6. He should not have a previous record at Imam Abdul Rahman bin Faisal University.
7. To pass the tests and personal interviews specified for the program to be enrolled in.
8. The student must fulfill any other conditions required by the University Council and announced at the time of application.



Conditions and controls for admission of students with disabilities:

- Imam Abdul Rahman bin Faisal University is keen to provide the opportunity for students with disabilities who wish to study, by allocating a number of study seats in the programs available to them according to the category of disability and their health status, without prejudice to the controls and mechanisms regulating the admission of students, which include fulfilling the following conditions:

The mechanism for accepting students with disabilities:

A committee is formed annually by the person with the authority and its task is to look into the cases of students with disabilities after the completion of the screening and differentiation process among the students applying to the university in order to study and evaluate each case and conduct the necessary tests and interviews according to the documents and reports that show the health status of the student and then take its view on the possibility of accepting the case with suitable students in accordance with the case to educational programs for a specific

13. Master Degree Program in Special Education at IAU

The program aims to prepare special educators and teachers to be qualified theoretically and practically, and whom will be described as:

- Highly qualified theoretically and practically.
- The standards of their qualification meet the national and international learning disabilities institutions' criteria. These criteria include identification, training, qualification, and working with students with learning disabilities in K-12.
- Mastering cognitive, numerical, communicative, vocational and research skills that enable them to be efficient competitors that meet the workforce needs in the field of learning disabilities, in accordance with the criteria of the national qualifications' framework.
- Willing to serve students with learning disabilities and their families in the Saudi society.
- Maintaining improvement in the field of learning disabilities through continuous special education programs, training, and raising awareness of the characteristics and educational needs of students with learning disabilities.
- Committed to Saudi ethical, cultural and religious standards.



17. A day for Human Rights commission at IAU



The Human Rights Commission in the Eastern Province held an initiative entitled “A Day for Human Rights Commission” at Imam Abdulrahman bin Faisal University through establishing an awareness booth in the Supportive Deanships Building today, Thursday, October 26, 2023. The event was attended by the Director of the Human Rights Commission in the Eastern Province, Ms. Nawal Al Bawardi, and the Director of the Public Relations and Media, Dr. Tufail Al-Yousef.

Ms. Al Bawardi stated that Imam Abdulrahman bin Faisal University is considered one of the success partners of the initiative as through this cooperation, an awareness booth for the Human Rights Commission was activated to introduce the goals and tasks carried out by the commission, which confirms our keenness to deliver sound information about the commission’s regulations and legislation to the students. The booth introduced the rights guaranteed by the national systems and the international agreements to which the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia has joined. It also introduces the efforts undertaken by the commission to raise awareness about these rights, and the services it provides to the beneficiaries. In addition, it presents information about the channels of communication, and it provides consultations from specialists who also offer some souvenirs. Ms. Al Bawardi added the commission aims to protect and promote human rights, in accordance with the Islamic Sharia. She said that the commission is the governmental body competent to express opinion and advice regarding human rights issues, it is responsible to ensure that relevant government agencies implement all the laws and regulations regarding human rights, which will develop awareness and preserve rights.

For his part, Dr. Tufail Al-Yousef welcomed the Commission team, appreciating their choice of Imam Abdulrahman bin Faisal University to introduce this initiative, which comes based on the university’s cooperation with various sectors in light of the Kingdom’s Vision 2030 and its goals that emphasizes the university’s support to the Human Rights Commission for its pivotal role in promoting and protecting human rights in the Kingdom. This comes to deliver the desired message of introducing the commission and all the aspects that must be realized by

- Race, color, or nationality

TITLE: ANTI-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to affirm Imam Abdulrahman Bin Faisal University's commitment to providing a learning and working environment free from discrimination. The university aims to uphold the principles of equality, diversity, and inclusiveness for all students, faculty, staff, and visitors.

2. SCOPE

This policy applies to all members of the IAU community, including students, faculty, staff, contractors, and visitors. It covers conduct on campus, university-affiliated activities, and any form of communication within the university environment, whether in-person or online.

3. DEFINITIONS

TITLE: DISABILITY ACCOMMODATION POLICY

TITLE: ANTI- HARASSMENT POLICY

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to affirm Imam Abdulrahman Bin Faisal University's commitment to providing a safe and respectful environment free from harassment. The university strives to promote a culture of dignity and respect, ensuring that all students, faculty, staff, and visitors are protected from any form of harassment.

2. SCOPE

This policy applies to all members of the IAU community, including students, faculty, staff, contractors, and visitors. It covers conduct on campus, during university-sponsored events, and any interactions associated with the university, including digital and online communication.

3. DEFINITIONS

- **Harassment:** Unwelcome behavior, whether verbal, physical, visual, or digital, that demeans, intimidates, or threatens an individual or group based on characteristics such as gender, race, nationality, religion, age, or disability.
- **Sexual Harassment:** Unwanted sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, or other verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature that affects an individual's academic or work performance or creates a hostile environment.
- **Bullying:** Repeated aggressive behavior intended to hurt or intimidate another individual, which may involve verbal abuse, physical actions, or online harassment (cyberbullying).
- **Retaliation:** Any adverse action taken against a person for reporting harassment or participating in an investigation.

- The participating student's GPA should not be less than 3.75 out of 5.
- The student should be distinguished with an effective and vital role in student activities inside the college and the University.
- The previous champion of "the College Dorah "pearl" is not permitted to participate in the current competition.
- The current academic year graduates are not allowed to participate in the competition.
- Submit an innovative project that serves the University's community.

- If the previous conditions apply to you, then you are illegible to register in the competition and you should submit the following papers:
 1. Your Academic Record.
 2. Fill out the competition form.
 3. Attach a photocopy of the University ID.
 4. Provide the required participation certificates.
- Each college will form a committee to choose the college Dorah, the committee should have one member from the Vice Deanship of Female Student Affairs.
- The Colleges Dorah Evaluation Points:

Cumulative Average

The student's cumulative average for all the achieved semesters and will be granted 20 points.

Evaluation Process

1. Cumulative Average (Student Grades x 20) ÷ 5
2. Participation in the Deanship of Female Student Affairs activities will be granted 20 points.
3. Participation in college activities will be granted 10 points.
4. Participation in representing the University will be granted 20 points.
5. Participation in community service activities will be granted 15 points.
6. Student talents will be granted 15 points.
7. The personal interview will be evaluated for 10 extra points.
8. Participation Calculation points in activities or representing the (University - college- or the Deanship of Female Student Affairs):
9. For every activity the student holds; either in or outside of the University. She will be awarded 2 points with explaining her achieved role.
10. Attendance of activities held by the college or the Deanship of Female Student Affairs without having an active role; the student will be granted 1 point for every activity.
11. The accepted activities will start from September 2013.

12. Student talents such as: (recital of parts of the Holy Quran - recital of the Hadith - innovations - scientific research - designing - singing) or other talents that the committee considers as so.
13. In case the student provides a scientific research paper, she will be granted 5 points and if she discusses her paper in an inside or outside conference she will receive 5 extra points.
14. Every talent will gain 1 point out of 15 for the talent section. The student that can recite the whole Quran by heart will receive 5 points and who is proficient in the English Language will be granted 2 points.
15. Community Service is that the student volunteers in a work that serves the community and she should provide proof of that. Every activity will be granted 1 point.
16. Community service will be accepted starting from July 2013.
 - The Winners of the College Dorah will receive:
 1. A Certificate.
 2. A Tablet.
 3. 5000 SAR.
 - If the student is illegible to compete in the University Dorah Competition:
 1. The Cumulative average will be excluded.
 2. The student will be evaluated according to the points she received in the College Dorah Competition as well as a personal interview carried out by a committee that consists of members form the Deanship of Female Student Affairs.
 3. 10 points will be granted by voting on a private link that will be posted later on.
