- Illustrate the importance of involving all segments of society in order to develop a common vision for the future of sustainable development through training on the pyramid of the United Nations 2030.

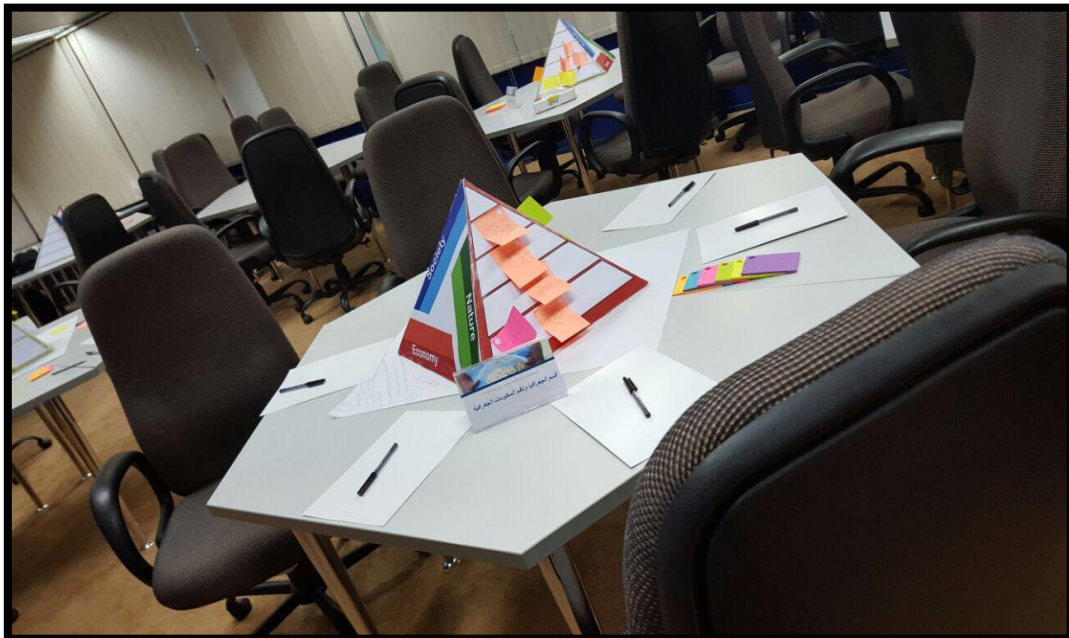
Outcomes of the Workshop

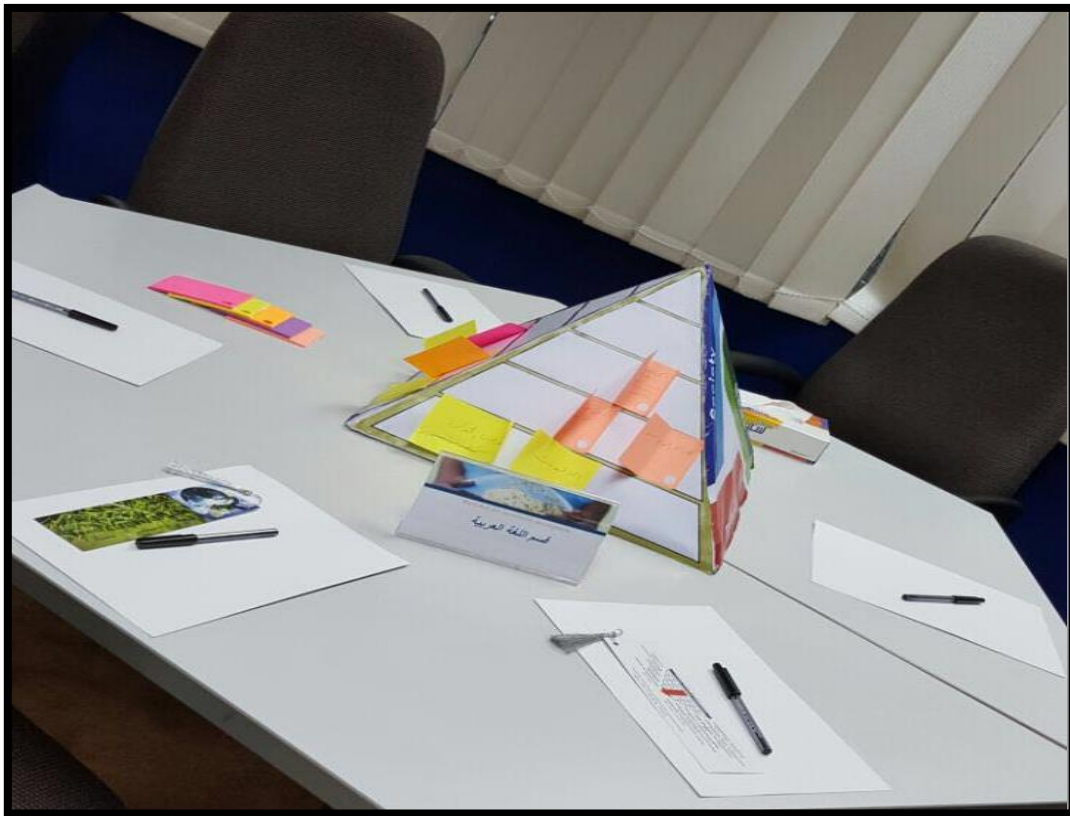

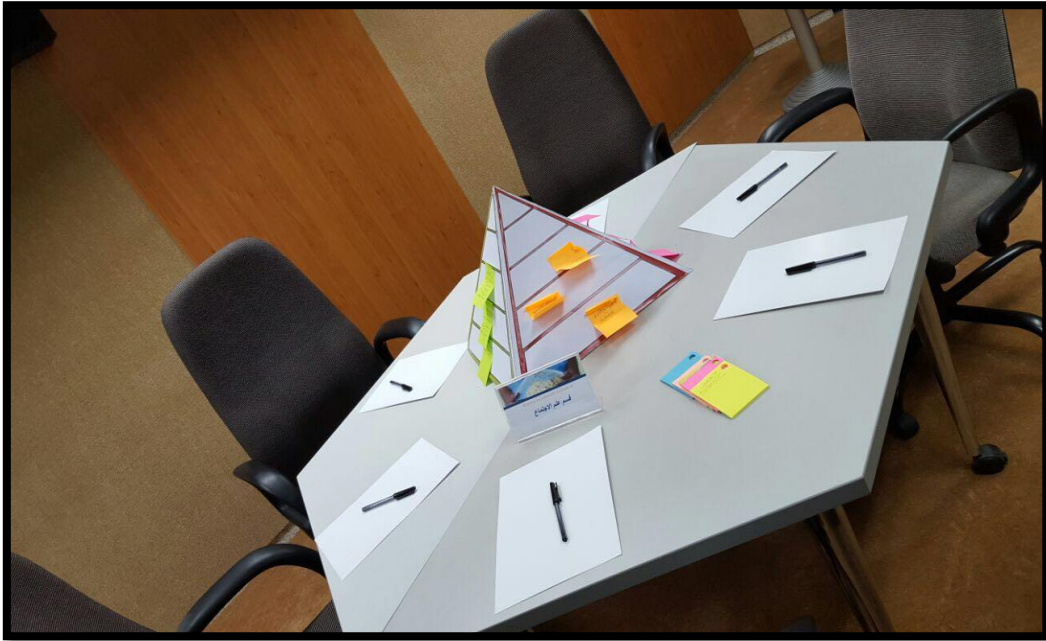
